Forex-Kitty — Quick Start Guide

Thank you for your purchase. This guide takes you from a fresh download to a running, licensed EA in about ten minutes.

1. What's in this package

File	Purpose
Forex-Kitty.ex5	The Expert Advisor for MetaTrader 5 (compiled)
SetFiles/ (6 files)	Calibrated configurations: 5 currency pairs + a \$5,000 EUR/USD starter

2. Requirements

- **MetaTrader 5** with a **hedging** account (not netting — Forex-Kitty holds BUY and SELL positions simultaneously).
- A broker offering the traded pairs at a spread at or below the EA's **MaxSpread** (30 points by default).
- A **VPS** is strongly recommended so the EA runs 24/5 without interruption.
- Internet access from the terminal for the hourly license check.

3. Install the Expert Advisor

1. In MetaTrader 5, open **File** → **Open Data Folder**.
2. Go to **MQL5\Experts** and copy **Forex-Kitty.ex5** into that folder.
3. Back in the terminal, right-click **Navigator** → **Expert Advisors** and choose **Refresh**. Forex-Kitty now appears in the list.

4. Allow the license server (one-time, mandatory)

Forex-Kitty verifies your license once per hour over the internet. You must allow its URL, otherwise it cannot confirm the license.

1. Open **Tools** → **Options** → **Expert Advisors**.
2. Tick "**Allow WebRequest for listed URL**".
3. Add exactly this address: **https://kitty-ea.net**
4. Click **OK**.

Note: The license is bound to your account number, not to a key you type in. You register your MT5 account number(s) once in your Customer Area — see the next step.

5. Register your trading account

1. Log in to your Customer Area at <https://kitty-ea.net> (use the license e-mail you received).
2. Open **My Licenses** and enter the **MT5 account number** you want to run Forex-Kitty on.
3. Select whether it is a **Live** or **Demo** account.

Your single license covers **1 live account and up to 5 demo accounts**; the 5-license pack covers 5 live and up to 20 demo. The broker is locked to an account on first use for security.

6. Load a currency pair

Each supported pair has its own calibrated set file with a unique magic number, so you can run several pairs in parallel from one terminal. Attach Forex-Kitty to the chart of the pair, then load the matching set file.

New in v1.20

Forex-Kitty now ships with a third entry engine, the **EMA25 return opener**: it starts new cycles during calm drift phases when neither the sniper pullback nor the Bollinger re-entry fires, entering in the direction of the higher-timeframe trend once price returns to its EMA25 base line. The range-entry RSI levels moved from 40/60 to 45/55. In the full 2024–2026 real-tick backtest this raised net profit while slightly lowering the maximum drawdown. A new \$5,000 EUR/USD starter configuration (0.01 lot grid) is included as `ForexKitty-EURUSD-5K.set`.

1. Open the chart of the pair (any timeframe — signals are evaluated internally on M5/M15).
2. Drag **Forex-Kitty** from the Navigator onto the chart.
3. In the dialog, open the **Inputs** tab, click **Load**, and select the matching set file.
4. On the **Common** tab, make sure "**Allow Algo Trading**" is enabled, then click **OK**.
5. Confirm the **Algo Trading** button in the toolbar is green. The on-chart dashboard should now show the EA status.

The suggested deposit is per pair and reflects the deposit used in our published back-tests. Trading with less increases risk considerably.

7. How Forex-Kitty trades (in brief)

An **ADX gatekeeper** on M15 decides the market regime. In a **trend** it waits for EMA-fan pullbacks with rejection candles; in a **range** it trades Bollinger re-entries confirmed by RSI. Positions are managed as a basket with a volume-weighted take-profit, an **escape mode** when the trend breaks, and a **waterfall reduction** where the best winner pays off the worst loser. Grid additions always require a fresh signal — never blind averaging at fixed intervals. From a set drawdown threshold a **Money Pot** sets aside realised profits and spends them to pay down the position furthest from price in the smallest tradable steps — balance-neutral, using the account's own winnings.

By design, Forex-Kitty uses no stop-loss. Risk is managed through grid density, the waterfall reduction, the Money Pot and the optional hedge module. This is a deliberate strategy choice — please make sure you understand and accept it before trading live.

8. Key parameters

The set files are calibrated — you normally do not need to change anything. The most relevant inputs, should you want to review them:

Parameter	Meaning
MaxSpread	No trading above this spread — entries <i>and</i> exits (protects against rollover spikes).
StartLot / LotStep	Initial lot and increment per grid level (0.1 / 0.1 by default).
MinDistance	Minimum distance between grid positions — the core defense (per set file).
Enable_Spread_TP	Adds the current spread on top of every target so the full profit stays net.
Enable_Time_Filter	Blocks new entries outside trading hours; existing positions are still managed.
Enable_Aggressive_Hedge	Optional hedge module (off by default), triggered by drawdown and distance.
Enable_Moneypot	Money Pot (on by default): from <code>Moneypot_Feed_DD_Level</code> (20%) realised profits are set aside; from <code>Moneypot_Rescue_DD_Level</code> (30%) they pay down the worst position, balance-neutral; below <code>Moneypot_Reset_Level</code> (10%) the pot resets.
